I have initiated and developed a nationally & internationally recognised tertiary service in neonatal & paediatric airway surgery, in collaboration with intensive care, cardiac, and other allied specialties. We have now achieved a department with 5 consultants in paediatric ENT, a Post CCT Paediatric ENT Fellow, Paediatric Tracheostomy Nurse Practitioners, and a definitive SHO level Trust Paediatric ENT doctor; we are now awaiting confirmation of a 6th consultant post.

I initiated a new (now funded) multi-disciplinary Vertigo service: this streamlines assessment, investigations and management of dizzy patients and involves ENT Vestibular physiotherapy and Audiology for adults

Continuing excellent stapes & cholesteatoma surgery for adults and children; outcomes confirmed on clinical research, presentations & audits.

My practice now includes cochlear implantation in both adults and children (from age 5 months)
